\$3,000,000 NTE/ year



# Amendment to Bestway Custodial Services Contract for Parking Garages and Plaza Area

• <u>Project Description</u>: Contractor to perform and provide all labor, tools, transportation, services, and equipment necessary and reasonably essential to professionally perform janitorial services for parking garages (~2,150,000 sq ft) and plaza area (~ 60,000 sq ft). Amendment increases the labor rate for years 3-5.

Schedule: Start Date: April 1, 2020

Contract Duration: 5 years

# **JWN Hangar Rent Model**

- February 17, 2021: Board approved CEO recommended business model
  - Direct Costs + Operating Costs + ROI = Total Rent
  - Annual review of operating expenditures and CPI-U escalation
- July 1, 2021: CEO Implemented approved Rent model
  - July 2021 June 2022 (Base Rent Established)
  - July 2022 June 2023 (No Rent Increase Pandemic and On-going Development)

#### CEO + Board Fiduciary Responsibility

- Grant Assurance 24 Fee and Rental Structure maintain a fee and rental structure for facilities at the airport which make the airport self-sustaining
- CPI-U increased 13.5% in last 24 months (2021 7% + 2022 6.5% = 13.5%)

#### Financial Analysis Conducted by Staff

– JWN operations more efficient than simple CPI-U adjustment of 13.5%



# **JWN Hangar Rent Model**

- New rent equates to average 9.5% (less than CPI-U of 13.5%)
  - Average increase in monthly rent = \$36
  - Two-year cumulative increase of \$72
- April 2022: Tenants will be notified of new rent effective July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024.
