

### February 2024


- Sites 2A, 2B, and 7 do not meet gate count requirements both in the near term and long term
- Sites 1 and 6 have <u>problematic</u> <u>airfield inefficiencies</u> (e.g., runway crossings, increase in aircraft taxi times)

### April 2024

- Site 5 eliminated due to:
  - Metro IDB Location
  - Metro Parks Investment
  - Dell/Amazon Investment


Terminal II – Sites 3 & 4 warrant further consideration





Terminal II Short-List - Sites 3 & 4







- 7 CONRAC sites explored for each of the two short-listed TII sites
- Three sub-options for the B CONRAC Site (B1, B2, & B3)
- Site A is difficult to access from I-40
- Sites D & E require a longer connection to T1
- Sites B1, B3 and C rank the highest relative to evaluation criteria


