Doug Kreulen is President and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) for the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority (MNAA), responsible for both Nashville International Airport® (BNA®) and John C. Tune Airport® (JWN®). Kreulen joined the airport authority in 2012 and was named president and CEO in December 2017.

Prior to joining MNAA, he served four years as Director of Operations for the Huntsville-Madison County Airport Authority. Before beginning his career in the commercial aviation sector, Kreulen served in the United States Air Force for 27 years.
